Landfill Restrictions On Ink Waste!

Further to our Newsletter 9 of 1st September 2006 regarding the Waste Acceptance Criteria (WAC) that applies to all landfill sites, Saxon are adopting measures to assist our customers to separate waste in order to avoid added costs.

This applies to the following waste streams:

Ink Tins - Metal
Ink Pots - Plastic
Rags & Wipes

Landfill sites will not longer accept Plastic Ink Pots or Rags & Wipes therefore it is important that these materials are not mixed.

In order that your operatives do not mix materials in one container, Saxon will provide:-

Extra containers to isolate each material
Labels for containers to identify the material to be stored within
(Example overleaf)

Initially customers from whom we receive mixed containers will be informed but on the second and subsequent occasions mixed materials are received we will have no alternative but to charge customers with the cost of sorting prior to onward disposal.

The sorting surcharge that is over and above the agreed collection rate is as follows:

205 litre drum -	£45
Grey pallet box -	£55
1000 litre IBC -	£55
